TYPES OF SCAMS TARGETING OLDER ADULTS

- · Grandparent Jail/Bail Scam
- · Lottery winner
- · Government or Utility Impostor
- · Family/Caregiver Scam
- Romance Scam
- · Homeowner Scam

HOW SCAMS TAKE PLACE

- Telephone most common way to connect without ever meeting the person
- Internet/Emails opening an email, clicking on a link gives the scammer access to your computer
- In person burglary, home improvement contractor, real property expert
- Regular Mail fake lottery letter, foreclosure/mortgage assistance

SIGNS OF A SCAM

- · Unknown person is asking for cash
- · Payments must be in cash, gift card or wiring to a stranger
- · Sense of urgency and secrecy
- Request for Personal Information

HOW TO PROTECT YOURSELF FROM A SCAM

- · Be aware of signs of a scam
- Avoid unsolicited offers for help
- · Ask yourself, "Does this sound too good to be true?"
- NEVER act immediately, always confer with a trusted person


